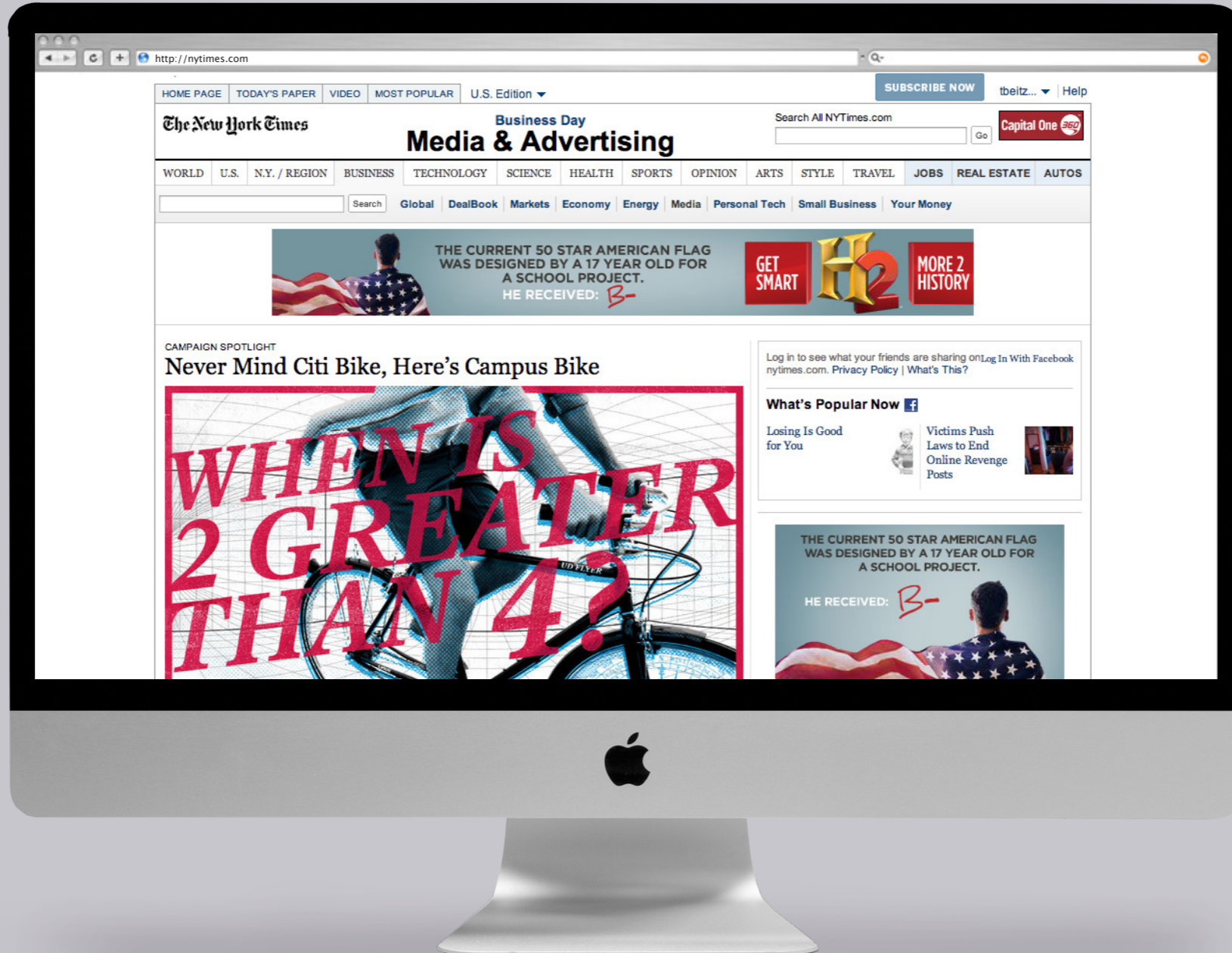

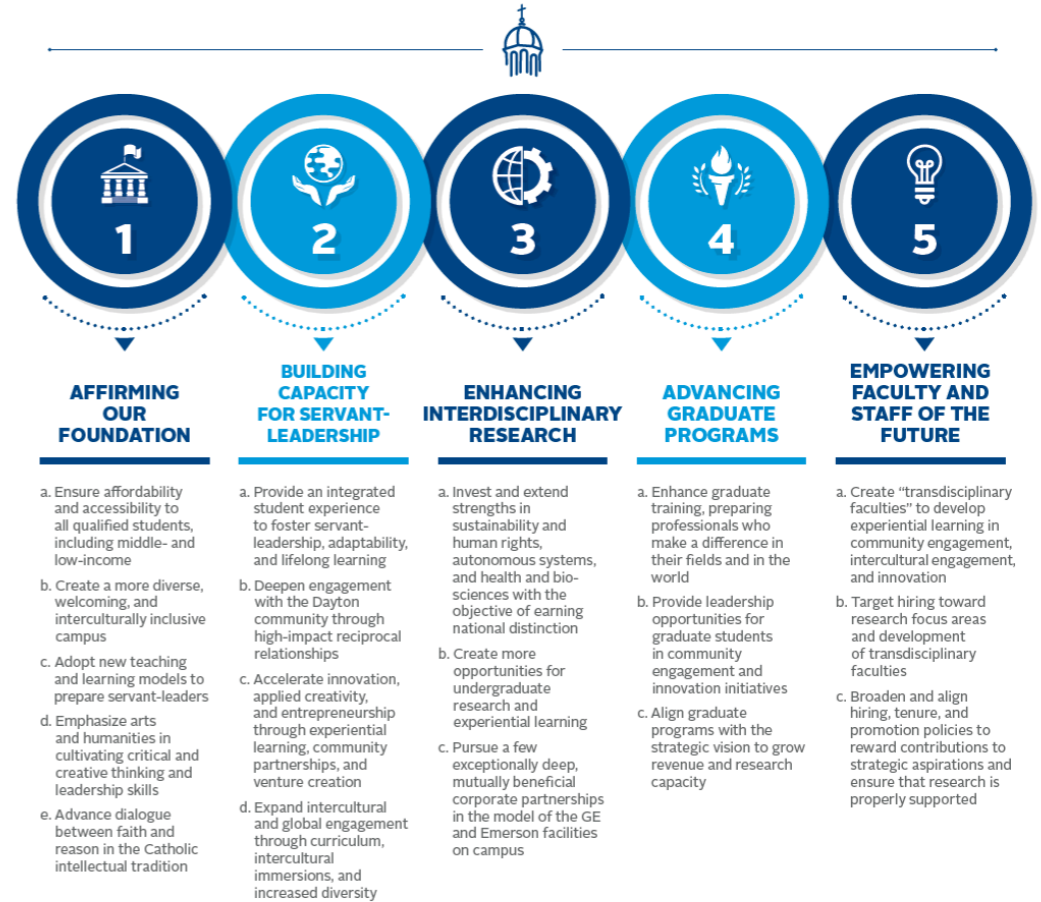

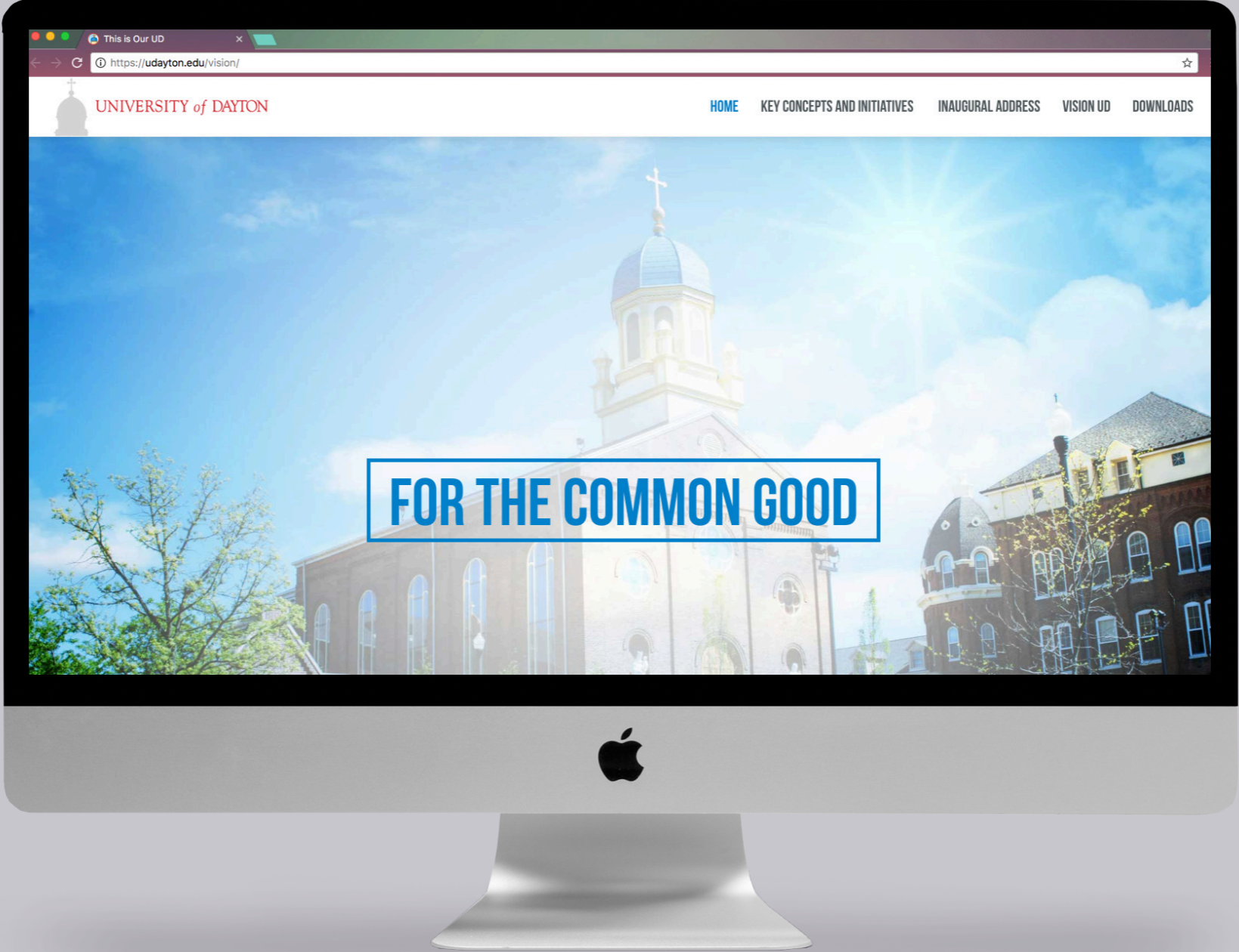

AT UD, WE BELIEVE IN ASKING BIG QUESTIONS. OUR BIGGEST ONE NOW IS, 'WHAT'S NEXT?'

THE UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON HAS CONVERTED INTELLIGENT RISKS INTO PRODUCTIVE OPPORTUNITIES, AND IT WILL CONTINUE TO PURSUE THEM WITH STABILITY AND DIRECTION.

The University of Dayton's board of trustees renewed President Curran's contract through 2022, and, in charting the path for the University to follow with his leadership, the University crafted three guides, the Vision of Excellence, the Strategic Plan and a Master Plan.

These documents create a united vision for the next decade and beyond. "One of the University's greatest strengths has been — and will continue to be — its ability to look ahead," said Curran. "Together as a community we have put several plans into place, uniting us with a clear-eyed sense of purpose. These plans will galvanize our community and enable UD to extend its mission well into the future."

In just a decade, what will we see?

We will see a top-tier national university known globally for scholarship and research that improves the human condition. Professors and presidents at peer universities will adopt

our curricular innovations and continue to look to the University as a source of influence for academic programs that inspire curious and conscientious young men and women. In a world fractured by divisiveness, our graduates will stand out not only for their competence but also for their moral commitment and community-building skills.

A newly graduated nanomaterials engineer will be instantly recognized for her UD diploma at a job interview in Berlin, and a proud parent of a UD student will be spotted in a Flyer T-shirt in Beijing. Talented high school students who dream of attending a prestigious Catholic university will be reassured that they will be admitted on a need-blind basis and challenged to reach their full potential at the University of Dayton. And people with only a passing knowledge of the University will know what Marianist means and why that word symbolizes UD.

Faced with an extraordinary time of opportunity, we will build for the future with faith and confidence. The development of campus between Brown Street and the Great Miami River will dramatically change our landscape, expanding the "front porch" of campus and spurring economic development.

Our alumni will return home to UD with their families and old friends, and they will continue to look upon their alma mater with immense affection, not just because of what they learned here but because of who they became here.

The Catholic and Marianist tradition that anchors and sustains the University of Dayton calls us to go out into the world, seek truth and lead in the building of community. We are called to commit acts of courage and compassion and meet the world's challenges together. In answering this call, we draw strength from our faith — and from each other. We will lead. We will adapt. We will transform.
