What You Need to Know

- The new Tsai Leadership Program at Yale Law School will provide students opportunities for courses in accounting, corporate finance, statistics, ethics and more.
- The school established the program through a partnership with alumni.
- The program's courses and opportunities will be open to all Yale Law students, whether they pursue traditional legal careers or take a nontraditional path.

Yale Law School began a new chapter for the institution Nov. 3 with the opening of its Tsai Leadership Program, which aims to prepare students for both traditional legal practice and nontraditional career paths.

The program establishes new courses and opportunities for professional development. Coursework in the program includes accounting, corporate finance, statistics, ethics and emerging issues related to technological change, Big Data and globalization.

"The Tsai Leadership Program will help us build on our best traditions even as we reinvent them in order to train every student for their last job, not just their first," Yale Law School Dean Heather K. Gerken said in a statement. "We hope it will support a new generation of changemakers, equipping them to meet the challenges to come while carrying forward the highest ideals of the law school."


